

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-4

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE GOLF
COURSE MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE STATE
OF OHIO'S COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Section 9.12 of Article IX of the Charter of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio, provides the method under which the City Manager shall make certain purchases and enter into contracts on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Ash has been participating in the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program since the late 1980s, which is coordinated by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, and represents the result of a formal bid process at the State level relating to the acquisition of certain supplies, vehicles, services, equipment and materials; and

WHEREAS, the need exists for the purchase of golf course maintenance equipment funding for which has been approved by City Council in the 2018 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Golf Course Maintenance Department requests authority to purchase one (1) Toro 3500 Mower; two (2) Toro MDX Utility Vehicles; and one (1) Toro 1750 Multi Pro Sprayer from Century Equipment through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program (Contract #800261-STS515) for an amount not to exceed \$86,000.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio,

SECTION I.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Century Equipment through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program (Contract #800261-STS515) for the purchase of one (1) Toro 3500 Mower; two (2) Toro MDX Utility Vehicles; and one (1) Toro 1750 Multi Pro Sprayer for an amount not to exceed \$86,000.

SECTION II.

The Treasurer is hereby authorized to expend the necessary funds therefor, which funds are hereby appropriated.

SECTION III.

This resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption.
