

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-31

AUTHORIZING CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN THE
OHIO MUNICIPAL LEAGUE (OML) WORKERS'
COMPENSATION GROUP RATING PROGRAM; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 9.12 of Article IX of the Charter of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio, provides the method under which the City Manager shall make certain purchases and enter into contracts on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Officer recommends that the City continue its participation in the OML Worker's Compensation Group rating program for the period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, with the option (upon approval by the City Manager) to renew annually for up to four additional one-year contract periods.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio, not less than five (5) members thereof concurring,

SECTION I.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to renew the agreement to participate in the Ohio Municipal League Workers' Compensation Group Rating Program, and utilization of OML's selected Administrator (currently Gates-McDonald) for the period from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, with the option to renew annually for up to four additional contract periods.

SECTION II.

The Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer are hereby authorized to expend the necessary funds therefor, which funds are hereby appropriated.

SECTION III.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio; the reason for the emergency being the need to address certain personnel requirements for City employees and the support functions for the Human Resources Office. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
