

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-66

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2009-39 RELATED TO THE REED HARTMAN
HIGHWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT FOR SUPPLEMENTAL LINE ITEMS; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 9.12 of Article IX of the Charter of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio, provides the method under which the City Manager shall make purchases and enter into contracts on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City was allocated funds through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), also known as stimulus funds, for the rehabilitation of Reed Hartman Highway from Cooper Road to Glendale-Milford Road; and

WHEREAS, this allocation of federal funds was awarded via suballocation to agencies within the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana (OKI) region, with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) having oversight responsibilities for the project; and

WHEREAS, after following a formal bid process, City Council approved Ordinance No. 2009-39 in July 2009 which authorized a bid award and contract for the Reed Hartman Highway Rehabilitation project to the John R. Jurgensen Company for unit prices and estimated quantities as attached to that ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the need exists to add the following changes, with the total cost of these changes being \$9,125.78:

- Spec Item 614, Work Zone Channelizing Line, Class I; add 5,519 l.f. at \$0.42 per l.f.
- Spec Item 614, Work Zone Channelizing Line, Class III; add 5,750 l.f. at \$0.42 per l.f.
- Spec Item 614, Remove Existing Crosswalk Striping; add 206 l.f. at \$3.30 per l.f.
- Spec Item 448, Additional Asphalt Material Only to Re-profile Cooper Road; add 68.75 tons at \$54.00 per ton.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Blue Ash, not less than five (5) members thereof concurring,

SECTION I.

Ordinance No. 2009-39 is hereby amended to reflect the addition of the following items associated with the Reed Hartman Highway Rehabilitation Project:

- Spec Item 614, Work Zone Channelizing Line, Class I; add 5,519 l.f. at \$0.42 per l.f.
- Spec Item 614, Work Zone Channelizing Line, Class III; add 5,750 l.f. at \$0.42 per l.f.
- Spec Item 614, Remove Existing Crosswalk Striping; add 206 l.f. at \$3.30 per l.f.
- Spec Item 448, Additional Asphalt Material Only to Re-profile Cooper Road; add 68.75 tons at \$54.00 per ton.

SECTION II.

The Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer are hereby authorized to make the aforementioned expenditure, which funds are hereby appropriated.

SECTION III.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Blue Ash; the reason for the emergency being to provide for continued progress and appropriate payment for this road improvement project. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
