

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-42

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RENEW A
CONTRACT WITH THE DISTRICT ADVISORY COUNCIL
OF THE HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, GENERAL
HEALTH DISTRICT FOR PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES
FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2011 FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$42,909.01; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 9.12 of Article IX of the Charter of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio, provides the method under which the City Manager shall make certain purchases and enter into contracts on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to renew a contract with the Hamilton County Board of Health for state-mandated health services (said services also referenced in City Charter Article XV).

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio, not less than five (5) members thereof concurring,

SECTION I.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Chairperson of the District Advisory Council of the Hamilton County General Health District for public health services for the City of Blue Ash as required by the Ohio Revised Code (and referenced in City Charter Article XV) for the period of January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 for an amount not to exceed \$ \$42,909.01.

SECTION II.

The Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer are hereby authorized to expend the necessary funds therefor, which funds are hereby appropriated.

SECTION III.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio; the reason for the emergency being the need to provide for public health services to serve the citizens of Blue Ash. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
