

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-45

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A 2010 CONTRACT WITH YOUTH SERVICES OF READING, OHIO, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$37,000 (INCLUDES BASE CONTRACT WITH OPTIONAL ADD-ON SERVICE); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio, not less than five (5) members thereof concurring,

SECTION I.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a renewal of the City's base contract with Youth Services of Reading, Ohio, for educational, advocacy, referral, counseling, crisis intervention services, juvenile diversion activities, and general youth programming for calendar year 2010, for an amount not to exceed \$37,000, which includes the flexibility to provide additional optional professional services.

SECTION II.

The Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer are hereby authorized to expend the necessary funds therefor, which funds are hereby appropriated.

SECTION III.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio; the reason for the emergency being the need to provide for the availability of youth and family counseling services as well as creative programming for the youth and families of the City of Blue Ash, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
