

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-4

AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT REQUEST WITH  
THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE FOR THE  
CONTINUING EFFORTS ASSOCIATED WITH DRUG USE
