

The Basics

Who can play?

Our leagues are available for anyone 18 or older. There is no need to have any Blue Ash Affiliation either; in fact the majority of our teams have no affiliation. However, we do give priority to those teams that are comprised of Blue Ash business members or residents. (see below)

Registration

We run a designated registration period for each season. The period usually runs 12 days and completed registration forms can be emailed (bkruse@blueash.com), faxed (513-745-8527) or handed in to the front desk at the Blue Ash Recreation Center. Registration forms are available about 2 weeks before the registration period and can be found on the website or in the Blue Ash Rec Center lobby. Forms are also emailed to the interest lists (see below) about 2 weeks before the registration period. We only accept team registrations; individuals may sign up on the free agent list (see below).

Email Interest Lists

If you know you are interested in a league, simply get in touch with Adam Bowling at abowling@blueash.com to be placed on the interest list. It's simply a list of folks who are interested in getting registration forms emailed to them about 2 weeks before the registration period. Your email never goes anywhere else, we promise! Keep in mind that our interest lists are long, and not fool-proof. We get many that bounce back to us that we are not able to follow up with. It's always best to follow along with the league calendar for dates of the registration periods.

Captain's Meetings

We hold a captain's meeting for every team sport prior to the season start. The meetings are mandatory, and any player from the team can attend. If a team fails to show, they may be replaced by a waiting list team. At the meetings, we will collect registration fees, hand out schedules, cover league rules/policies, and cover all of the basics that you will need to know. If you are a returning team, you still must send a representative from the team. Being that we do not collect fees until this meeting, it helps us assure what teams are officially registered for the league.

Fields and Courts

All indoor sports are played at the Blue Ash Recreation Center at 4433 Cooper Rd. Blue Ash, Ohio 45242. Softball is played at the beautiful fields located at the Blue Ash Sports Center at 11540 Grooms Rd. Blue Ash, Ohio 45242. Ultimate Frisbee is played on the fields directly behind the Recreation Center. The city prides itself on offering safe and attractive facilities for you to enjoy.

Free Agent Lists

Interested in getting in on the action, but don't have a team? Sign up on the free agent list and your contact information will be given to the team captains at the manager's meeting. If a team is in need of an additional player, they may contact you to join their team indefinitely or sub for a few games. There is no charge to be on the list and your name will be kept on the list through that specific season. There are no guarantees either, but hopefully you will get picked up so you can get out there and play!

“Business” and “Resident” Teams

A team is considered a “Business” or “Resident” team if they have the minimum amount of players necessary to compete in a match *on their original roster* who either live or work in Blue Ash. (ex. Basketball: 5, Volleyball: 6). These team’s registrations are given priority if handed in during the registration period.
